**(1) Mrs R A Wright & Miss J Cranfields ZEFATHER'S TWO FACES WITH IRIEUSDANE**

This 7 month fawn male puppy took my eye when he came into the ring. What a beautiful head this boy has; lovely dark mask, dark, almond shaped eye, good ear set, nice length of foreface with even breadth throughout and a super kind expression. This promising puppy has a natural elegant balance to his profile with good depth of chest leading into a good tuck up; level topline, nice tight cat feet. Good hindquarters, moved out very well especially given his young age and handled beautifully. So pleased to award him **Best Puppy Dog** and **Best Puppy In Breed**, congratulations and best of luck with him.

**(2) Mr M Jacques & Mr P Kirby JACQUKIR TAKE ME HOME(AI)**

Six month fawn male puppy, heavier type than 1. Good head shape gives appearance of equal breadth with a square drop of lip, dark eye, soft expression. He has a good length of neck leading into well laid shoulders, brisket depth to elbow, good tuck up. He covered the ring with ease, reaching and driving well, just needs to tighten up on his forelegs which I am sure he will do as he matures. Another super puppy.

**(1) Mrs S Tempest ADOREADANE YELLOWSTONE(AI)**

Very smart 11 month mantle puppy dog, strong chiselled head with dark eye of good shape, good ear set and carriage, slightly broad in back skull, good strength and width of foreface, body well balanced in profile for a young boy. Good lay of shoulder and depth of brisket, forelegs straight. Good width of second thigh, just needs to strengthen on the rear which I am sure he will do as he matures, moved out well.

**(2) Miss T & Mrs L Pocock and Mr & Mrs Pavlou BUBBA VON PAO EBERJAGER WITH TAMZDANE(IMP FCA)** 9 month mantle puppy dog. Well set ears carried nicely, good length of foreface with square drop of lip, overall head not as developed as 1 yet. Strong neck set well into his shoulders, good depth of chest, nice tight cat feet, good length of second thigh and turn of stifle. Moved out well with his handler.

**(1) Mrs A McLellan ANADAIN DEAD RINGER FOR LOVE**

A very handsome 20 month fawn male, giving the impression of both strength and elegance. This boy has a lovely masculine head with good head planes, nice length and breadth of foreface, well chiselled, good square drop of lip, beautiful dark mask, good ear carriage. Clean strong neck, lovely depth of brisket to just below his elbows, well filled in front, good return of upper arm, strong flat bone to forelegs, level topline leading into well-developed hindquarters with good length and width of second thigh. Shown in

super condition, moved out well pushed hard for the CC just not quite got the elegance of movement yet and I am sure this will settle as he matures. Pleased to award him Reserve Dog Challenge Certificate.

**(2) Mrs M & McGuiness and Mrs S Nelson-McGuiness DINATRON THE OMEN**

Fawn male, nice level head planes, nice dark eye, square drop of lip and well-set neck, good lay of shoulder, good depth of brisket, would prefer slightly more return of upper arm, level topline, moved out well.

**(1) Mrs A McLellan ANADAIN LIFE IS A LEMON**

Fawn male, lovely balanced profile, super head balanced in size for his body, flat skull, well set ears proportionate in size to his head, good length and breadth of foreface, clean square drop of lip; straight forelegs with flat strong bone, well filled in front with good depth of chest leading into a clean tuck up; level topline which he held well, tail level with his back used his hindquarters well on the move, presented in very good condition.

**(2) Ms M Palmer ADOREADANE CHARLTON(AI)**

Harlequin male, good head shape, well set ears, good eye shape, nice headplanes, clean square drop of lip, head set onto strong neck leading into well set shoulders, muscular well filled in front on this boy, front legs with strong flat bone, level topline which he held well while moving, steady mover who used his hindquarters to drive on the move, presented and handled beautifully.

**(1) Miss T & Mrs L Pocock CH/INT/LUX/SWISS CH TAMZDANE EMPOWER MINT JW**

Mantle male with strength, dash and dare and an abundance of elegance on the move. Lovely head on this mantle with very good headplanes, flat skull, good length and breadth of foreface, nice dark almond shaped eye, clean square drop of lip, nicely arched neck into well sloped back clean shoulders free of any wrinkles, powerful forequarters, with a well filled front, tight cat like feet, good body with well sprung ribs, a level topline which he held well on the move; a powerful set of hindquarters with good second thigh leading into well set hocks. This boy loves to move and he is a joy to watch, reaching out well with his front and driving powerfully from the rear he has a fabulous stride and covers the ground with that lithe springy free action that is a joy to see. Shown in beautiful condition and handled very well; so pleased to award him the **Dog Challenge Certificate & Best Of Breed.**

Six and half month-old fawn puppy bitch. Lovely balance all over to this puppy, her head is developing nicely with a beautiful dark mask, nice to see another puppy with a dark eye and good eye shape. Elegant neck onto clean well laid shoulders, she has a depth of brisket already reaching her elbows, supported by straight forelegs and nice tight cat feet, really good croup on his young girl and a good length of second thigh. So lovely to see her happy nature shining through and she loves to move, already moving out very well for her age covering the ground well with nothing turning in or out, will watch her develop with interest good luck with her.

**(2)J Bielecka ALEGRIAGIANT CASJOPEYA**

**Seven-month-old mantle bitch** of pleasing overall type. She has a nice dark eye which enhances her expression. Her backskull is slightly wide at this stage but should balance out with maturity. She has a correct drop of lip and a clean, well-defined white collar that adds to her classic mantle markings. Her topline is level and firm, although she is a touch long in the loin, she remains quite well balanced for her age. Moved well.

**(1)R C & M Bithell VERTUMNUS RAISE YOUR GLASS TO BOURTNWYN**

11-month-old fawn bitch of excellent size and development for her age. She possesses a beautiful head with correct proportions, a dark, tight eye and well-set ears of appropriate size, carried correctly. Her head has lovely parallel planes and a good length of foreface with a dark, well-defined mask, good length of neck that flows into clean, well-laid shoulders. She stands on tight cat feet with a firm, level topline, good depth of forechest reaching to the elbow and a well-drawn-up underline. She has a long second thigh and a well-angled stifle, once settled on the move, she covered the ground well with purpose and drive. A very promising young bitch whom I will watch with interest as she matures, pleased to award her Best Puppy Bitch.

**(2)Ms K M Le Mar FONTAANROSSA NOBLE MYSTIQUE**

**Eight-month-old harlequin bitch** showing confidence and assurance in the ring. She has a pleasing overall shape with good depth of chest and a correct tail set. Would have preferred a little more length of foreface but I am sure this will develop as she matures. She displays a clean white underground with a well-distributed array of torn black patches, giving her a classic harlequin pattern. On the move she was free and easy, covering the ground well for her age.

**13-month-old fawn bitch** of pleasing overall type and development. She has a well-balanced head with dark, expressive eyes, correctly level headplanes, and well-set ears of good size. Her head is well chiselled with a good width of foreface complemented by a dark mask and a correct, square drop of lip. She has a strong, clean neck flowing smoothly into well-laid shoulders. Her forechest is well filled, with a good length of upper arm allowing for reach and extension. Her topline leads into a correctly angulated croup, with a good length of second thigh and well-set hocks. On the move she excels,

showing excellent reach in front with strong drive from behind, covering the ground with ease and purpose. A very promising young bitch.

**(2) Mrs S Bourton-Thorne VERANO VIVA LAS VEGAS**

13-month-old fawn bitch of pleasing overall type. Not as settled on the move as the class winner at this stage, but still showing promise. Lovely head of good shape with a soft, feminine expression and well-set dark eyes. Ears correctly set and carried, adding to her appealing outlook. Presents a good front with correct angulation and a well-filled forechest. Level topline held well both standing and on the move, with a correctly set tail. Just needs time to fully settle and mature into herself.

**(1)Ms A Merwick TARADANES STAR VISION FOR SAALAN**

Elegant brindle bitch who immediately caught my eye with her presence and style, and that true look of dash and dare. Holds herself with confidence, using her head and neck to full advantage. Beautiful head of correct proportions, with lovely head planes, a dark almond-shaped eye giving a soft but alert expression, correct ear shape and carriage, good bite, and a lovely length of foreface with the desired breadth of muzzle. Square drop of lip with a clean underline completes the picture. Strong, long neck flowing into a well-laid-back shoulder and a level topline which she held well throughout. Excellent depth of chest with a nicely tucked loin, correct tail set, and good length of second thigh. Well-set hocks, covering the ground with ease and freedom, holding herself beautifully at all times. Shown and handled to perfection. Delighted to award her the **Bitch Challenge Certificate**.

**(2)Miss T & Mrs L Pocock TAMZDANE OOOEY GOOEY CAKE JW**

Harlequin bitch of pleasing overall balance and type. Lovely head when viewed in profile, with good head planes and correct proportions. Carries her ears well, enhancing her alert and intelligent expression. Clean, well-arched neck of good length flowing smoothly into well-laid shoulders. Forechest well filled with strong bone throughout, giving her the necessary substance without losing femininity. Moved out soundly with a lithe, springy action, covering the ground with ease and purpose.

**(1)Mr M & Mr P Jacques and Kirby JACQUKIR TIME FOR CHANGE**

Fawn bitch of elegance and quality who caught my eye on entering the ring. Beautiful, well-proportioned head for her size, with equal breadth throughout, giving a balanced and chiselled appearance. Good width of muzzle with a pleasing dark mask, completing the picture of a classic feminine Dane head. Neck of lovely length and

strength, flowing smoothly into well-laid shoulders. Exhibits excellent overall balance and proportion, both in front and hindquarters, which she used to full advantage on the move, covering the ground with ease and purpose. Pushed hard in the challenge—another top-quality bitch.

**(2)Miss P Henshall CALCHAS ADDITION(AI)**

Harlequin bitch with good white underground, presenting a pleasing overall picture. Head of nice shape with a dark eye giving a soft expression. Sufficient front angulation, with a fair depth of chest and good bone. Displays a well-balanced outline, holding her topline well both standing and on the move although not quite as settled on the move as the class winner today.

**(1)Mr E & Mrs D Clark CH GARSAK SUMMER DAYS AT MINTREX**

Fawn bitch of strong, balanced type who presented a very pleasing overall picture. Strong head with level head planes and good length of foreface, complemented by a dark mask and dark eye giving a typical expression. Good ear set, used well to enhance her appearance. Neck of good length flowing into well-set shoulders. Straight forelegs with flat bone and good depth of chest, providing both strength and elegance. Level topline leading into a well-set croup and correct tail carriage. Balanced throughout, used her hindquarters effectively to drive her sound movement around the ring. Pleased to award her the Reserve Bitch Challenge Certificate.

**(2)Mrs L M Collett FOALDOWN DARK SECRET**

Black bitch of pleasing type with a kind, gentle expression and well-shaped eye. Lovely length of neck flowing cleanly into well-laid shoulders. Strong front with straight forelegs and flat bone, giving both strength and elegance. Slightly longer in loin than the class winner, shown in beautiful condition. Moved freely and with ease around the ring, covering the ground well with her handler.

Seven-and-a-half-year-old fawn bitch who oozes confidence, strength and elegance, presenting a picture of maturity and quality. Beautiful, well-chiselled head with a flat skull, broad muzzle, and kind, expressive eye of correct shape. Good ear size and set, complementing her classic head. Lovely square drop of lip with a clean underline, giving an beautiful profile to her head. Well-constructed front with correct angulation and a well-filled forechest, with depth of chest reaching to her elbow. Strong, level topline held well both standing and, on the move, leading into a well-set croup and tail. Good length of second thigh and low-set hocks, providing the drive to her movement.
